Ships:	2 Cruisers	***
	2 PT Boats	**
	1 Aircraft Carrier	****

Instructions: Pick 20 Vocabulary Words — Write 10 down the left side and 10 across the top. Make sure your opponent has the same words in the same spaces.

In the grid squares, use X's to mark the squares where your ships are located (one X per square). Hide all 5 of your ships in this way. NOTE: YOU MUST LEAVE SHIPS INTACT. (ie. - The X's for the cruiser must have 3 in a row either horizontal or vertical, - no diagonal ships.).

Fold the top of the paper toward you on the dotted line to hide your ships from your opponent. Each person takes turns guessing the location of the opponent's ships by signing one word from the left column and one word from the top.

(**OR**: to practice numbers, pick one number from the top and one from the side). The other person looks where those two words (or numbers) intersect to see if they have hidden a ship there. When your opponent guesses right, then sign "hit." If not, then sign "miss." When your opponent has guessed all the X's that make up one ship, sign "sunk."

When you guess right, make a mark on your grid to show you have found a ship. Then on your next turn, guess above, below, or on each side to find the other X's that go with that ship. If you guess wrong, put a circle in that square so that you won't guess there again. Whoever sinks all the ships of their opponent first, wins! Enjoy \sim
